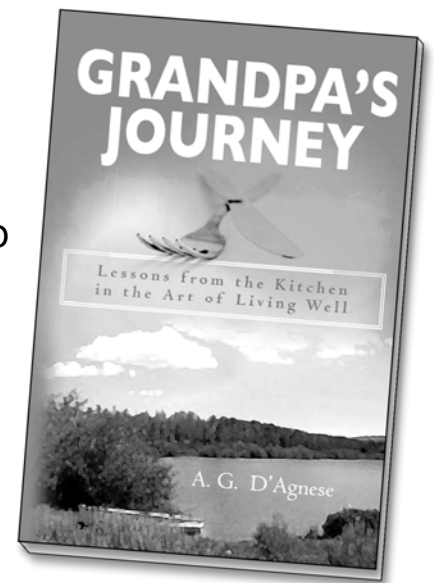
Lessons from the Kitchen in the Art of Living Well
